Donna Gabusi’s techniques of applying rough, bold, and surreal brush strokes on raw canvas, evokes a feeling of Abstract Realism in her work. She uses from one to three brushes and maybe two to five colors. There is no method to how she begins her drawing. She may begin from the bottom up, or with the background first. The subject comes to life from any point within her drawing each time she paints.

A native of Smithtown, Long Island, N.Y., Donna has been painting and drawing for about 10 years. She displays her work all over Long Island in galleries, libraries, cafes, and stores. She has been artist of the week on WLIW’s (Channel 21) award winning cultural art show, “Ticket” and cover artist for the Huntington based cultural arts magazine, “Canvas”.

Donna’s acrylic paintings are of Long Island landscapes. She draws old trees, woods, broken fences, paths and light. She is influenced and inspired by the dark emotional pieces of Munch to the French Impressionists Pissarro and Van Gogh. Mother Nature has been her biggest inspiration.
