Beginning as the calligrapher for “Terrace on the Park” in Queens, she later opened her own business, HAM/KAP Creations, whose clients include Cablevision’s Charles Dolan, SPLIA, Broadway show openings, restaurants, schools, and hundreds of brides.

While keeping her “day job” as a calligrapher these past 25 years, she began writing “Shrinking Violet”, a comic strip about a bright young woman who keeps panic and depression literally stuffed in her pockets. Named Pepper and Smudge, they pop in and out of Violet’s pockets to unsettle her world.

Her love of children inspired her to write her children’s books: “Rainbow Hair”, “Everyone Except Me”, “The Sprinkles Snatcher”, and “The Day My Mom Returned Me to the Library”. She also enjoys running the Drama Club at Cold Spring Harbor High School.
